

2023 LADBROKES INTER DOMINION PACING FINAL CALCUTTA – TERMS & CONDITIONS

Participants must be 18 years of age.

TICKET DRAW

Tickets are \$10 each and are available both prior to and on the night. The Calcutta commences with one ticket being drawn for each runner in the 2023 Ladbrokes Inter Dominion Pacers Final. If your ticket is drawn, you 'own' that horse ahead of the auction stage!

All proceeds from the ticket draw go into the prize pool.

THE AUCTION

Auction will run in Ladbrokes betting order, highest odds to lowest odds.

Each horse will be auctioned to the attendees at the Calcutta, who can bid for that horse.

You can bid on your own, or you might choose to pool resources with others. After the announcement falls on each runner: 50% of the sale price goes to the person who drew that horse in the ticket draw which can be collected at the end of the night; and the remaining 50% goes into the ever-growing prize pool. The highest bidder in the auction stage becomes the new owner of that horse.

Successful bidders must pay for their horses on the night – Cash and EFTPOS/Credit Card facilities will be available.

AFTER THE RACE

After the running of the 2023 Ladbrokes Inter Dominion Pacers Final on Saturday 16 December 2023 the prize pool (consisting of all ticket sales plus 50% [fifty per cent] of auction proceeds) is divided as follows: 60% to the owner of the winning horse; 20% to the owner of the second placegetter; 15% to the owner of the third placegetter; and 5% to last place.

Successful bidders will receive prize money by bank transfer on Tuesday 19 December 2023.

In the event of a 'dead heat' where two or more horses cannot be separated by examination of the Stewards, the relevant winning stake for each placing involved in the dead heat will be added together and then split evenly between the winners associated with the horses involved in the dead heat.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Entrants purchase tickets for the chance of being allocated a horse.
2. A draw will be made to allocate horses to ticket buyers until all horses in the field of 12 are exhausted. Horses will be drawn from random using a barrel. The Emergency will not be drawn.
3. If successful in drawing a horse, you MUST place this horse up for auction.
4. You will receive 50% of the highest bid for your horse and the highest bidder becomes the new "owner". The other 50% remains in the prize pool.
5. If in attendance on the night, you may bid for your own horse. If successful, 50% of the amount paid will enter the prize pool while the other 50% is returned to you.
6. Horses will be auctioned in reverse Ladbrokes market order – i.e. roughies first, favourites last.
7. Successful bidders at auction gain "ownership" of the horse and are entitled to a share of the prize pool if their horse runs a place in the nominated race on race night.
8. All of the Auctioneers decisions are final.
9. The Albion Park Harness Racing Club has absolute discretion to change any of these Terms and Conditions.
10. All other contingencies not accounted for in these terms and conditions are to be resolved at the sole discretion of Albion Park Harness Racing Club.

BUYER BEWARE: - If a scratching occurs after the Calcutta, the scratched horse will be replaced by the 'emergency horse' and the owner of the scratched horse will be allocated the 'emergency horse'. In this instance the Club will contact the owner of the horse at the Club's earliest convenience.

Should there be another scratching, a late scratching or a horse is disqualified or declared as a non-runner by the QRIC Stewards there will be no refunds.
